

Minot Forest Committee Meeting Sept. 16, 2022

Open meeting: 5:36pm

Present: Sandy Slavin, Angela Dunham, Linda Scharf

Absent: Judy Wetherbee

Guests: Josh Quackenbush and Marcus Gomes from Cranberry Country Disc Golf

Attendees are looking for a place in Minot Forest, suitable for disc golf activities.

Josh notes that start space should be the most open lane between trees.

Baskets shouldn't be within 50' of the trail. Want to keep activities 75'-100' away from wetlands. We walked part of Donald's loop, assessing for appropriate areas. Walking uphill to Eversource right of way, considering a fairway up the hill.

Sandy asks about 2 possible baskets just off the trail.

Parameters: 120'/shortest fairway, 550' longest, par 4 comparable

Sandy suggests a 9 hole course if space were available and landscape details were right for such a course, and wondered whether CPC funds would be available for course construction and basket purchases.

Legal consultation with town would be needed before any agreement.

Sandy will ask Eversource about orange markings on trees. Disc golf stewards would maintain, create signage.
