King George's War to Present

The Wareham Veterans Board was put up in memory of those who served during World War Two. The key for it was in the possession of Wareham Post 220, The American Legion. It was reported that the board was broken into and some letters were removed. The key was turned over to the Wareham Veterans Agent so that the letters could be replaced. At that time there were names removed to make room so the names of veterans from Korea and Vietnam could be added. While there is no objection to listing veterans from the Korean and Viet Nam Wars. This board was a specific listing of World War Two veterans.

In an attempt to return it to this. It was discovered that replacement letters were very expensive. It was also discovered that there was no central listing of World War One veterans. There was a listing of veterans from Onset in Onset. And it was discovered that there was a bell in the East Wareham School that listed the veterans from East Wareham. After some research it was discovered that the board in the Town Hall only listed about half the veterans who served in World War Two.

This is what started the present listing. It was an attempt to recognize the men and women who served in the Armed Forces during World War One and make a complete listing of those who served in World War Two.

There was no listing of those who served after World War Two so it was decided to include those who have served from World War One to the present.

The Soldiers and Sailors Monument at the Town Green lists the veterans from Wareham from King Georges War down to ,but not including , World War One. '
