




Waste disposal regulations

Listed below are materials (and their definitions) which have been restricted from being taken as part of any curbside or drop-off trash program in Massachusetts.

<p>CATHODE RAY TUBES (CRT'S) (4/1/00) Any intact, broken, or processed glass tube used to provide the visual display in televisions, computer monitors and certain scientific instruments such as oscilloscopes.</p>		<p>Special Sticker 508-291-3100 Harbormasters Office, ext. 3186</p>
<p>LEAVES AND YARD WASTE (12/31/91) Deciduous and coniferous leaves, grass, clipping, garden materials, shrub trimmings, and brush up to one inch in diameter.</p>		<p>Dump Sticker 508-291-3100 Harbormasters office - ext. 3186</p>
<p>WHITE GOODS (12/31/91) An appliance using electricity, oil, natural gas or liquefied petroleum gas to preserve or cook food, to wash or dry clothing, cooking or kitchen utensils or related items, or to cool or heat air or water. <p>WHOLE TIRES (Landfills Only) (12/31/91) Whole car and truck tires of all types. Can be landfilled only if it has been shredded or ground into at least four pieces and so no longer circular in shape.</p>		<p>Recycling Drop-off Center next to Park-N-Ride, E. <p>LEAD ACID BATTERIES (12/31/90) Used in motor vehicles or Stationary applications</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">FREE Recycling Drop-Off Center, Park-N-Ride E. Wareham</p>

<p>METAL CONTAINERS (4/1/93) Aluminum, steel or bi-metal beverage and food containers</p>		<p>FREE Recycling Drop-Off Center, Park-N-Ride E. Wareham</p>
<p>GLASS CONTAINERS (4/1/93) Glass bottles and jars excluding light bulbs, plate glass, ceramics, Pyrex cookware, drinking glasses, windows, and windshields</p>		<p>FREE Recycling Drop-Off Center, Park-N-Ride E. Wareham</p>
<p>PLASTIC BOTTLES (12/31/94) (Single Resin Narrow-necked Plastics) All narrow-necked plastic containers of any resin type. In narrow-necked containers the diameter of the opening is smaller than the diameter of the base (e.g., a soda bottle is “narrow-necked” but a yogurt container is not).</p>		<p>FREE Recycling Drop-Off Center, Park-N-Ride E. Wareham Plastics #1 and #2 ONLY (at this time)</p>
<p>RECYCLABLE PAPER (12/31/94) All paper, cardboard, and paperboard products, unwaxed cardboard and cereal boxes <i>DOES NOT INCLUDE: tissue paper, toweling, paper plates, cups and other low-grade paper products No used products taken.</i></p>		<p>FREE Recycling Drop-Off Center, Park-N-Ride E. <p>HAZARDOUS WASTES ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BE DISPOSED OF AT SOLID WASTE COMBUSTION FACILITIES, LANDFILLS, AND AND/OR AT TRANSFER STATIONS.</p>

- * **Appliances with CFC's (See White Goods for further information)**
- Arts and Crafts Supplies (Certain supplies may contain toxic materials)**
- Asbestos**

- * **Batteries (Automotive) – Free at Wareham Drop-Off Center, E. Wareham)**

Waste Ban Materials (Continued)

- * **Batteries (Household) – Alkaline (AAA,AA, C, D, 9volt) Throw in trash.**

Driveway Sealer

- * **Electronics and CRT's (TV, computer monitors – CMW Regional Refuse)**
- Fire Extinguishers (Call Fire Department?)**
- * **Fluorescent Lamps (CMW Regional Refuse)**
- Home Medical Waste**
- * **Mercury Devices Liquid Mercury (CMW Regional Refuse)**
- Motor Oil and Oil Filters**
- Muriatic Acid (HCl) (CMW Regional Refuse – Haz Waste Days)**

- * **Paints and Stains (Wareham Recycling Drop-off, East Wareham) \$1/gallon**
- Pesticides – (CMW Regional Refuse - Hazardous Waste Days)**
- Photo Chemicals**
- * **Propane Tanks (SEMASS pays residents \$1 per tank – subject to change)**
- Smoke Detectors (Remove Battery and place in trash – not harmful)**
- Thinners and Solvents (CMW Regional Refuse – Hazardous Waste Days)**

Wood, Treated (may be reused in landscaping; do not burn in fireplace)

Wood with Lead Paint (keep away from children and pets)

- **Items may be taken to sites mentioned; The Drop-off Center does not require stickers or proof of residency. Some items require payment to take (tires, paint, white goods).**
- **Items taken by Carver-Marion-Wareham (CMW) District require a dump sticker and/or special stickers. Call Harbormaster's Office for further information (508) 291-3100, ext. 3186.**
- **Printed information is available on the Wareham Recycling website or may be picked up from the Harbormaster's office in the basement of Town Hall or at the Wareham Recycling Drop-off Center. If the Center is closed fliers providing information are usually available on the gate in special boxes made by members of the Recycling Committee.**
