### **East Wareham, MA; Wednesday 16 June 2010**

The Wareham Fire District Water Department “cut the ribbon” on their latest project, a 209,000 Gallon Water Storage Facility, located at 285 Glen Charlie Road, East Wareham, MA on the site of the Fire Department’s Station 3. An open house was held with a continuous slide show of the project from start to finish, in addition, engineers; commissioners; and tank storage folks were on site to field questions.

The project, which was approved in an amount not to exceed \$1.5 million, came in substantially under budget at less than \$1.3 million. The funding did include some site improvement to the Fire Station Grounds and is funded by the Capitol Improvement Project line, and billed to the water users on a consumption-based formula. Noticeably absent was Superintendent Michael A. Martin who was on active duty training for the military.
