Abatement may be granted if boat is transferred by sale or otherwise, or if the owner of a boat subject to such excise, removes to another state, and registers a boat in such other state and surrenders, or if boat is overvalued or exempt. No abatement may reduce the excise collected to less than \$5.00. The filing of this application does not stay the collection of your excise. It should be paid as assessed. Refund will follow if abatement is allowed.
