1. **South Coast Bikeway Alliance:** Michael reported that the March SCBA Annual Meeting was successful.
2. **Wareham Pathway Plan:**
 - a. Michael will contact Alan Slavin and Derek Sullivan to inquire about the status of the engineering estimates for the Minot Avenue Pathway that were sent out to the designated firms following the November 2016 meetings.
 - b. The WBPC will conduct further research to determine options that might provide potentially safer and less expensive alternatives for the future bike path extension projects.
 - i. Look into newly acquired town properties.
 - ii. Joan will contact Jackie Schmidt Jones to inquire if it might make sense to (1) re-open a discussion with Eagle-Holt about a possible right-of-way, and (2) find out if there are any changes with the State about utilizing area adjacent to an active rail line, both of which could positively impact the path route moving forward.
 - c. The WBPC will explore a route from Minot Avenue to the Tremont Nail Factory as the potential next phase of the Pathway. Joan will bring maps to the May meeting for the Committee to review.
