Mr. Wallace stated that this is an upgrade of an existing system. The property currently has a cesspool. Plan is to put in a microfast system. The property is tight and has wetlands all around. There is a well on site 80.3 feet away from the existing system and the ground water is high.

Mr. Perry questioned why the 100 feet from the on-site well couldn't be met.

Mr. Wallace replied that the owner wants to keep the driveway and distance from the wetlands.

Mr. Perry stated that if the system were slid north 15 feet it would meet the requirements and asked if the well is shallow or deep.

Mr. Wallace replied that doing so would cut off access from the house to the main driveway. He stated that he would be willing to shift the system over from the well and provide a wall. He does not know if the well is shallow or deep.

Mr. Perry suggested making the system wider and shorter with retaining walls.

Mr. Wallace stated that they will work with it and confirm if the well is deep or shallow and try to re-size the system.
