4:10 p.m. Stable Regulations- Discussion on Title XVI, Chapter 111: Section 155 156-157.

Section 155 -: Stable section 155 discusses fees "in no event shall any such fee be greater than forty dollars. Section 156-157- "Whoever violates any provision of the two preceding sections or of a regulation or order made thereunder shall be punished by a fine of five dollars for each day such violation continues." Mr. Ethier stated the Board of Health could set their own fees/fines. Dr. Wiegandt stated the Board of Health regulations under Section 1, Animals- S.- VIOLATIONS OF THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS WILL BE SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN \$50.00 AND LOSS OF STABLE PERMIT. The Board agreed this \$50.00 would cover all fine/penalties.
