Selectman Munise stated that the goal is to provide service that is affordable. Selectman Tropeano stated that this will be a continued discussion until a decision is made.

Mr. Sullivan stated that the civil service list for the Police Department is out for the Chief and lieutenants. Mr. Sullivan asked that one of the members of the Board of Selectman become involved in drafting a contract.


