Director's Report:

For the month of July there were four internments: three (3) cremations and one (1) full burial. Mr. Menard stated that the operation of having the 375 gallon water tank aide with filling the rain barrels in the cemeteries have worked out very well. He stated that this month has been fairly quiet with just mowing and weed whacking the cemeteries.

Old Business:

Three errors were found in the original printing of the new, adopted Rules and Regulations booklet. Mrs. Bird returned the booklets and they should be reprinted by July 23, 2018. Deborah J. Mrs. Bird went before the Board of Health on July18, 2018 to request the Board of Health to accept the parcel of land and allow the Town of Wareham to use the Agawam Cemetery for burial purposes, of which they agreed too. She would like to receive any information pertaining to Centre, as this land might need to be approved as well.
