Affordable Housing Trust has granted \$100,000 if remaining funds can be obtained. Slavin moved to grant request for \$635,000. Jaime Rebhan seconded. Vote: 3-2-0.
- **Vikings Athletic Club** Requesting \$75,000 for new concession stand and ticket booth. Recommendation to table request until more information available.
- 4 Housing Units at Agawam Village Wareham Housing Authority requesting \$453,000 for four additional housing units to accommodate 6 residents. Worthen moved to support, Rebhan seconded. Vote 5-0-0.
- Union Chapel Restoration Wareham Historical Society requesting \$55,350 for repairs and upgrades. Bill Lockwood made motion to approve, Rebhan seconded. Slavin abstained. Vote 4-0-1.

Financial Report: Slavin reported that CPC has funds available to support all grant requests. She distributed listing of open projects. All CPC financial numbers are in synch with the Town Accountant's.
