**Call to Order:** Sandy Slavin opened meeting at 6:01pm.

## **Project Discussion**

Lillian Gregerman Bandshell – Total request reduced from \$357,724 to \$330,000.
 Proponents met with Steve Ruiz at WCTV, reduced audio visual line item from \$39,750 to \$21,784. Municipal Maintenance will help with demolition. Onset Bay Association (OBA), through the Town of Wareham, has liability insurance. A "clerk of the works" will be hired under "soft costs." Fund raisers are being planned including possible request for matching grant from MA Cultural Council.

Agawam Housing - Request for 3 buildings, two units each, for \$980,000.
 Waiting list of 700 currently closed. 86.5% elderly, 13.5% handicapped/non-elderly. Use of CPA funds, separated from DHCD funds, will allow new units to have local presence.

## **Committee Votes**

**Tremont Nail** – Town is requesting \$1,430,000 for required environmental clean- up. Funding would be bonded, costing CPC @ \$170,000 per year over ten years. Funding will come from undesignated funds. Jean Connaughton moved to submit as town meeting article. Joe Leggett seconded. **Vote: 6-0-0** 

**Agawam Housing** – Funding of \$980,000 would include \$650,000 from Housing Reserve Funds and \$330,000 from Undesignated Funds. Leggett moved to submit as town meeting article; Sherbie Worthen seconded. **Vote:** 6-0-0

**Bandshell** – Funding of \$330,000 total: \$250,000 from Open Space/Recreation, \$83,000 from Undesignated Funds. Leggett moved to submit article; Connaughton seconded. **Vote: 6-0-0 Financial Report** – Slavin reported on paid invoices.

Minutes, 8/8/18 — Correction noted(?). Connaughton moved to accept amended minutes; Leggett seconded. Vote: 6-0-0

**Agawam Housing, Citizen Petition** – If BoS does not vote to place article on the Warrant, Committee will prepare a Citizen Petition. Leggett moved to support Citizen Petition. Barbara Smith seconded. **Vote: 6-0-0** 

**September 6, 2018 -** Deadline for submitting Articles.

September 12, 2018 - Next CPC meeting.
