A site inspection was made at 110 Parkwood Dr. The project involves the construction of an addition within a coastal flood zone. A 26x29' addition is proposed within Coastal Flood Zone AE el 15. The work is not within the buffer zone to any other resource areas. The project is within existing lawn area. The grade is relatively flat but there would be some minor grading to be done around the addition as shown on the plan. Mr. Pichette recommended the issuance of a Negative Determination #2 for the project.

A site inspection was made at 2683 Cranberry Highway. The project involves upgrading a septic system in the buffer zone to a Bordering Vegetated Wetland (BVW) and within a Coastal Flood Zone. An existing cesspool is to be replaced with a new Title V nitrogen reducing septic system. The new leaching field will be 61' to the edge of the BVW. The leach field will be raised 2' from the existing grade with proposed contours shown on the plan. A couple of existing concrete pads will need to be removed to accommodate the new leach field. Dewatering may be necessary during the installation and a dewatering sediment trap is shown on the plan. Mr. Pichette recommended relocating this further from the edge of the BVW. Hay bales and silt fence will be installed between the work and the resource areas. A DEP file # has been received. Mr. Pichette recommended the issuance of the Order of Conditions with the standard conditions with the added condition to relocate the dewatering basin to a new location further from the BVW and that all demolition material be removed from the site.
