#### MINUTES OF MEETING OF WAREHAM CONSERVATION COMMISSION

#### I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

#### III. PRELIMINARY BUSINESS

#### A. Approve meeting minutes: May 4, 2016 & June 1, 2016

Ms. Slavin believes the May 4, 2016 minutes were previously approved as amended. She also believes Ms. Lydon was not an Associate Member at the hearings. Ms. Lydon stated she was not an Associate Member at the time. The minutes were amended. Ms. Heard believes she was not an Associate Member for the June 1st hearing as listed. She stated she was still an Associate Member at that time; she did not become a full member until July 26, 2016.

The minutes were not approved at this time.

#### IV. PUBLIC HEARINGS

## A. RDA – Scott & Elaine Robertson, c/o G.A.F. Engineering, Inc.

Present before the Commission: No-one was present

A site inspection was made at 9 Stockton Shortcut. The project involves the removal of a tennis court and landscaping in the buffer zone to bordering vegetated wetlands and within a coastal flood zone. An existing tennis court and surrounding chain link fence approximately 25' from the edge of the wetland and within Flood Zone VE 17 is to be removed and replaced with loam and seed to match the existing lawn area which surrounds the court area. Concrete will be

excavated and removed from the site. Grading will match existing grade. Silt fence will be installed between the court and the resource area. Mr. Pichette recommended the issuance of a Negative #2 Determination for the project.

Ms. Slavin stated she would like to continue this public hearing to see how the applicant proposes to fertilize the lawn.

MOTION: Ms. Lydon moved to continue the public hearing for Scott & Elaine Robertson to February 15, 2017. Ms. Slavin seconded.

Present before the Commission: Michael Martin

The project involves the demolition of an existing dwelling and construction of a new dwelling in the buffer zone to a coastal bank and a coastal beach. A revised plan has been submitted.

MOTION: Ms. Slavin moved to close the public hearing for Michael & Nancy Martin. Ms. Lydon seconded.

Work had begun without the applicant first checking with him (the Agent) about the site and clearing it for work to begin. The hay bales were not properly installed before clearing had begun. Also, the trees that were cut were stockpiled outside the approved limit of work line. The Commission stated to the applicant that no further work at the site was to be conducted until the haybales were properly installed and inspected by the Conservation Administrator. Also, that the trees and debris that were placed outside the limit of work were to be moved back within the limit of work or removed from the site.

Mr. Brady acknowledged these requirements.
