

**SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS FOR REQUEST FOR DETERMINATION OF
APPLICABILITY**

1. When filing a Request for Determination of Applicability (RDA), the original and one copy (2 total) are to be submitted to the Wareham Conservation Commission along with a check made out to the **Town of Wareham in the amount of \$50.00.** Your application and plan must also be submitted electronically by emailing PDF's of these documents to dpichette@wareham.ma.us. One (1) additional copy must be submitted to the D.E.P., 20 Riverside Drive, Lakeville, MA 02347. Each copy must be accompanied by a Locus map and detailed plans of the proposed project.
2. The Commission cannot process your RDA without making an on-site inspection. To do this, we need your completed application and plans. All aspects of the proposed construction must be completely staked and identified, i.e., all building corners, septic and leaching field corners, and walls and fences must be marked along their entire length. We will also need to know the area in which construction activity will take place. For instance, the building you propose may only come within 50 feet of the marsh, but we want to know how much closer the construction vehicles/activity will come.
3. Your RDA will be advertised in the ***Wareham Week***, as required by law, in the legal section. A separate check made out to **Wareham Week in the amount of \$50.00** must be submitted to Commission when filing your RDA to cover the cost of the advertisement.
4. Direct abutters of the property boundaries must be notified in writing by Certified Return Receipt, first class mail. The return receipts must be provided to the Commission either before or at the scheduled hearing.
5. The Commission will make every effort to schedule your public hearing at the next available meeting, pending receipt of your completed RDA which should be delivered to our office at Memorial Town Hall, 54 Marion Rd., Wareham, MA 02571.
6. Upon receipt of a Negative Determination, **only** the work proposed in the RDA is permitted. Performing any other work which impacts a wetland resource area may result in the issuance of fines by the Commission.
7. Upon receipt of a Positive Determination, you will be required to file an NOI.
8. After a Determination has been issued by the Commission, there is a ten (10) day appeal period in which the Determination may be appealed to the D.E.P. The project is not to commence until the ten (10) day appeal period has elapsed.
