Α	Introduce Demand Responsive Pricing	Price primary on-street and off-street parking according to demand (charge the most in areas of highest demand (i.e. the Pier) and lowest/free in areas with lower demand (i.e. Hynes/Lopes fields).						
В	Protect Residential Streets	Create a protected residential parking permit program that limits on-street parking to permit holders. Permits should be made available to long term parkers (residents, renters, and employees).
