A meeting of the Wareham School Committee was held on Tuesday, June 26, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. in Room 228 of the Multi-Service Center. Members present were Joyce Bacchiocchi, Michael Flaherty, Rebekah Pratt, Laurie Spear and Mary Morgan as well as Superintendent Shaver-Hood and recording secretary, Michelle Ruiz.

Chair Bacchiocchi called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Chair Bacchiocchi informed the members of the meeting she, Dr. Shaver-Hood and Mr. MacMillan had with the Town Administrator and Selectman Slavin today about the meeting with MSBA tomorrow for its approval of the project and the Selectmen's vote to place it on the ballot. The next School Building Committee meeting is July 9<sup>th</sup> when the community sub-committee will present.

Tonight the Chair and Superintendent will discuss with the Selectmen the Stabilization Fund request and give an update on the building project.

The Committee was updated on the following:

- Status of portables - We are looking at used portables free but a cost to move them.
- East School - going back to the family due to restrictions on the building to be discussed on a future School Committee agenda.
- Former B&G Club building - keeping the weight room but meeting with the Gatemen to request an upgrade of a locker/weight room and perhaps the town renting the remaining space to GATRA. Chair Bacchiocchi had shared her concern with traffic with GATRA vehicles in this area.

Mr. Flaherty moved to adjourn, seconded by Mrs. Spear.
