Increase is edu will be seen on march 23 bill. Peter will contact both newspapers regarding the increase, so users know it is coming.

Long discussion regarding hauler fees, both septic and grease. Septic increase .02 (vote 4-0-0), grease increase .04 (vote 4-0-0) effective 4/1/22. Guy will notify all haulers.

Projected projects that could include zero % interest and potential debt forgiveness:

Outfall 149m

Hynes force main 3-6m

Water resilience at 3 sites for total 3m

Swift beach project – 3m cost

Electric hook-up for grinder pumps – own property owner and must hire electrician.

Sewer staff will monitor pumps – but if property owner causes failure – they are responsible for cost to repair.

Moratorium

Max out put is 1.5m6 gallons/day with 80% cap or 1.248m gallons/day

Currently we are at 1.3m which is above the 80% cap.

We are required to create a plan to handle the overage – we have no place to put the overflow.

A rainstorm will impact increase sewer flow for as many of 4 days. 1" rain equals 150k of flow. We must fix i&i. we must stop sump-pumps
