




Contract No. 1: Project Summary

- First of three construction contracts
- Approximately 28,000 LF (5.3 miles) of gravity sewers
- 4 Pumping Stations (Linwood Avenue, Indian Neck Road, Oak Street and Parkwood Drive)
- 5,000 LF of force main
- American Recovery & Reinvestment Act (Economic Stimulus)

Contract No.1: Construction Schedule

- Sewer Construction: May 2009 July 2010
- Narrows Road and Indian Neck Road

 either summer work, restricted hours or one lane of traffic open
- Oak Street non-summer months (Labor Day to Memorial day)
- Cross Country typically winter work
- Final Paving summer 2010 and 2011
