Clear Channel is prepared to propose to the Town the ability of posting public information, amber alerts, student of the month, graduating class, etc., using the billboard. The representative stated the applicant is proposing to pay \$10,000.00 to the Town for each face of linkage for the sign. The representative stated the applicant is also proposing to allot a specific amount of advertisement time for the Town each month free of charge. The representative stated the applicant is requesting a Special Permit/Variance to install the sign. The representative played a short video for the Board re: Clear Channel electronic billboards.

Mr. Morello discussed specifications of the electronic billboard, as well as construction phases.

Attorney Bello stated if the Board does not approve the application, then the applicant will go to another town and make their offer elsewhere.

Selectman Tropeano stated the BOS voted 5-0-0 in favor of this project. He feels it will enhance the current aesthetics and increase revenue to the Town. He states the sign would be a community sign, since they would have the ability to post information about the Town. He added there will not be any flashing lights or distractions & the sign will change every ten seconds and that's it.
