No signs are allowed on School property, utility poles, traffic poles, trees, bridges or overpasses.

No signs are allowed on State controlled roads, e.g. Route 28 (Cranberry Highway) and Route 6 (Marion and Sandwich Roads)

No signs are allowed on Wareham Historic District areas without written permission given by the Wareham Historic District Commission.

Signs must not impair the vision of motorists.

Signs must be removed within 48 hours after event has ended.
