9. TOWN BUSINESS

a. Update on COVID-19.

Mr. Sullivan stated the next phase of reopening has started and he understands the frustration the businesses are feeling, however, the Board of Health and Fire District must follow guidelines from the Commonwealth to insure the safety for all involved. Selectman Munise asked if restaurants will be able to offer outdoor seating on Town property such as Merchants Way. Mr. Sullivan stated this could happen, but he is concerned about public safety.

Selectman Slavin stated that establishments may be able to sell alcohol for outdoor seating with simple guidelines to follow and the license will be good through November 1st or until the Order is rescinded. This would have to be approved by the Board of Selectmen and require an application to do so. Selectman Tropeano stated that something should be put in place quickly to help the local restaurants.

Selectman Slavin stated that the State officially declared that the economy is in a recession as of February and there are no answers on the expected length of it. Tax revenues for the month of May were down 16% and 8% overall for 2020. The taxpayer foundation is predicting a six to seven million dollar short fall and the real concern is how it will impact 2022.

Water parks are still closed. Camps are now open along with adult and youth sports. Beaches are open as well and all have strict rules and guidelines to follow. Organized games are prohibited.
