Call to Order: Dave Heard opened meeting at 6:00pm, followed by Roll Call.

Meeting, 8/23/23: No Minutes recorded.

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Heard distributed proposed (summarized) Warrant Articles and the following Motion, inserted by the Select Board at the request of the Harbormaster, to transfer \$58,750 to Harbormaster's Maintenance and Improvements Account. This request is for the principle and interest payment towards a permanent Bond used to replace the Onset Pier Floating Dock System. (This is not a CPC funded project.)

- Article 8 6 Chapel Lane: Motion to transfer \$150,000 from Community Preservation
 Affordable Housing Reserve Fund for a grant to 6 Chapel Lane LLC and to require an
 Affordable Housing restriction on the building.
 Community Preservation Committee (CPC) voted 4-0-0 in favor of submitting Article for
 consideration at 2023 Fall town Meeting.
- Article 9 Mark's Cove Vista: Motion to appropriate from Community Preservation
 Open Space Reserve funds the sum of \$250,000 for a grant to the Wareham Land Trust
 to acquire 3.58 acres of forested land and salt marsh along the shore of Cedar Creek and
 Marks Cove and to acquire a Conservation Restriction on the property.
 CPC voted 4-0-0 in favor of submitting Article for consideration at 2023 Fall Town
 Meeting.
- Article 10 Westgate Property: Motion to appropriate from Community Preservation
 Open Space Reserve funds the sum of \$26,000 for a grant to the Town of Wareham,
 through its Conservation Department to improve the trails and add an
 observation/sitting deck on the foundation of the old pump house. CPC voted 4-0-0 in
 favor of submitting Article for consideration at 2023 Fall Town Meeting.
- Article 11 Affordable Housing Trust: Motion to transfer from CPC Undesignated
 Reserve the sum of \$150,000 for a grant to the Wareham Affordable Housing Trust,
 For use as that Committee may see fit. CPC voted 3-0-1 in favor of submitting Article for
 consideration at 2023 Fall Town Meeting.

Recent CPA Payments:

1. \$4,290 to Shangri-la Shores playground. at Fall Town Meeting. \$9,000 awaiting approval.

2. \$15,145 to Band Shell awaiting approval.

3. \$37,380 to Wareham Land Trust, Sawyer Property

Financial Report (sent by Sandy Slavin) Accountant working on finalizing. 2024 Balance over \$2 million after allocations.

Estimates - Open Space: \$500,000, Affordable Housing: \$400,000, Historic Preservation:

\$700,000 Admin: \$80,000, State Match: \$530,000. Interest, \$70,000

Simplified Report: Patrick Lester noted the current Financial Report on the town website is fairly complicated and suggested developing "a more transparent financial report".
