IV. FINANCE COMMITTEE MATTERS

A. Minot Forest School update.

Present before the FinCom: Project Manager

The OPM (Owner's Project Manager) explained the Minot Forest School project. The expected project cost, based on an escalated projected cost per square foot, is approx. \$90 million. Reimbursement is ~75% of allowed costs. The Massachusetts School Building Authority (MSBA) currently limits building costs to \$333 p/sq. ft. & site expenses to 8% of building costs.

B. School budget update.

Present before the FinCom: Kimberly Shaver-Hood, Superintendent of Schools

Susan Owen, School Business Manager Joyce Bacchiocchi, School Committee Chair

Ms. Shaver-Hood highlited several budget items, such as the following:

- Savings of approx. \$2.1 million from closing Minot Forest School & less 31 staff.
- \$65,000 for moving costs.
- Free full breakfast & lunch for all students. There used to be half-time lunch staff, now there is full-time lunch staff.
- Minot Forest will be partially laid up to reduce costs.

Ms. Smith spoke re: the schedule for Town Meeting preparation.

Ms. Smith spoke re: electronic voting.

C. Tremont Nail update.

It was stated that Selectman Teitelbaum is speaking about environmental issues at the Tremont Nail site. The estimate for the environmental clean-up is \$1.4 million in which the Town is responsible for. Environmental studies were not done in 2004.

The Community Preservation Committee will fund the cost w/ a ten year bond which will cost \$174,000 per year.

It was stated the Town will be going after the prior owners of the site re: this issue.

D. Wareham, Marion & Carver Refuse District update.

It was stated that there are no other entities that don't have audits. It is expected that dump stickers will go to \$300.00 per year.
