Roll Call: Giberti, Barrett, Burrows, Labonte, Hasenfuss

- 1. We are In trouble with equipment as it is old and has reached its useful life. We are looking for equipment that is gently used in the 5-8 year old range that we expect to last another 3-5 years
- 2. Tee cutting reels have arrived before the blower that was ordered.
- 3. Three cutting reels are needed.
- 4. Money has been set aside for a septic system.
- 5. The question was raised on whether or not the money is in an interest bearing account.
- 6. Sterling has put together figures from last years earnings.
- 7. To continue to be functional, we need 40 operational golf carts. The present carts have batteries that are old and need replacement.
- 8. Discussion ensued on electric vs. gas carts and whether to buy or lease.
- 9. Most carts are 15 years old and need replacement as attempts to maintain existing has become labor intensive and expensive.
- 10. Any replacements should have compatible charging systems.
- 11. Discussion ensued regarding increasing the golf cart charge to \$24.00 for single and \$36.00 for two as other courses do.
- 12. Check with Sterling on price of single and two riders at their other courses.
- 13. Four of the five items that are requested to be refurbished or replaced are used every day. Expenditures are to update equipment. Carts 25x\$21,000 = \$525,000, whereas batteries for 30 carts would \$21,000 and give us 30 working carts. Check contract to see what replacement costs are.
- 14. Check on Sterling vs Town requirement for equipment.
- 15. Current equipment needed Toro Mower \$3150., Rough mower \$4500., Fairway mower \$21,000. plus cart, Tota; \$525,000. Motion to accept G. Barrett second P. Hasenfuss. In favor 5-0-0.
- 16. Motion for batteries and gas carts Motion J. Giberti Second J. Burrows in favor 5-0-0.
