Jennifer moved to get a quote for a new roll-off; Amanda seconded. 4-0-0. Discussion of single stream: Ann Marie wondered how many returnables get mixed in with other materials? We'll have to wait and see.

Amanda will research companies for a shredding event. Marilyn says we could use grant money depending on cost.
