Reorganization Meeting

A virtual meeting of the Wareham School Committee was held on Thursday, July 2, 2020, at 5:30 p.m. The meeting was conducted using zoom technology and taped by WCTV for live broadcast and streaming.

Call meeting to Order/Roll Call: Members present were Michael Flaherty, Apryl Rossi, Joyce Bacchiocchi, Kevin Brogioli, and Mary Morgan as well as Superintendent Kimberly Shaver-Hood, Assistant Superintendent Andrea Schwamb, and recording secretary Jamle Wiksten.

Dr. Shaver-Hood called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. and asked Michael Flaherty, Acting Chair to lead us in the pledge of allegiance.

He turned the meeting over to Superintendent Shaver-Hood for the reorganization.

Mr. Flaherty asked if the August meeting can be held in person with social distancing and televised. Chair Bacchiocchi is hopeful, as there have been provisional measures made in the meeting room space.

Chair Bacchiocchi attended the Beam Raising Ceremony at the new elementary school building site. Future events will take place when the public can participate.

Ms. Rossi questioned the DESE proposal and the plans for the return to school. Dr. Shaver-Hood commented that there are three plans in place; return to school buildings with social distancing, hybrid, and remote learning. A committee has been formed with Staff, Administration, Parents and School Committee Members to work on the three plans.
