#### **Online Instruction**

Online instruction is going very well. The district had a head start on the planning which made for a smooth transition with all staff and students.

Other districts were not as prepared as we were, being slightly behind us with online instruction.

We have 7-8 students without internet access currently.

Most of our teachers were set up with google classroom beforehand so this made this easier on them.

Some students and staff have found this online learning to be significantly stressful. A su

rvey went out to students so we could get feedback on how things were going for them.

70 – 80% of our students are signing on to complete their online instruction.

We are hoping to close out term 3 the Friday before vacation. Students at this time should be doing approximately 2-3 hours a day of schoolwork.

#### Plans for Terms 3 & 4

Students will have until March 13<sup>th</sup> to pass in work for term 3. Term 4 will start the 27<sup>th</sup> unless we work through April vacation. If we work through April vacation, term 4 would start on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of April.

Mr. Palladino will share a FAQ form with all parents and students.

### **Final Exams**

Mr. Palladino would like to cancel all final exams. Less stress for the students.

He would like them to focus on term 4 and receive more instruction time. That way students would have more recovery time.

Another option would be if students in grades 8-12 who scored an 80 or better in a class would not have to take the final exam for the class.

### **Scholarships**

Scholarships have been emailed and posted on Naviance for all seniors to have access.

50% of our seniors will receive scholarships.

Some scholarships do not receive enough applicants, hope this does not have impact on our students.

Mr. Janicki has been very helpful to families throughout this process.

# **Potential Options**

## **Other**
