### 8. TOWN ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

Mr. Sullivan thoroughly explains the FY24 budget by breaking down the revenues/expenses with a slide show of many different charts. The estimated new growth is about \$450,000 and the total estimated revenue is about \$78,607,189. Mr. Sullivan then showed a dollar bill chart which breaks down where the Town money is going by percentages; 0% to Cultural and Recreational, 1% to Health and Human Services, 2% to Debt Services, 2% to New School Debt, 4% to Public Works, 4% for Upper Cape Cod Tech, 5% to General Government, 8% to State and County Assessments, 10% to Public Safety, 21% to School and Town Employee Benefits, and 43% to School. FY24 will be the first major state aid increase the Town has seen in eleven years at about \$13,696,953. All of the budget information in the slide show will be posted on the Town website.
