- 1) Mr. Campinha explained the problem at the Smiths Pump Station: What the problem was; we have a ten (10) inch ductile pipe that comes out of the building, many years ago they used asphalt for back fill, the pipe settled to the asphalt and had been rubbing all these years which came through the pipe (have pictures to show) really incredible. The leak has been going on for eternity. Had pump Trucks out there pumping every thirty minutes. This leaves me with some serious concern that there are other areas with this problem. Mr. Campinha let the Board know that Smiths Pump Station is back up and running.
- 2) Mr. Campinha is asking the Board to transfer \$218,000 out of the unforeseen budget to the expense budget; \$100,000 will go towards the Smiths Ave project and \$116,000 towards the repairs of the roofs at the plant.
