1. Woodland Cove – 40B project

As point of information, Chairman Giberti reported that a letter with recommendations was sent to the Zoning Board of Appeals (ZBA). 1. Discussion of consolidation of Policies #2, #4 and #6 (cont'd from Feb. 22, 2018)

Commissioner Dunlop raised questions regarding power source to force main connections if the case of a power loss over 48 hours. Should property owner be required to provide their own power source (e.g. generator) be included in the policy? Commissioner Bronk suggested that this be discussed when the Superintendent is in attendance.

Commissioner Dunlop raised the question if the Sewer Commissioners be part of the approving authority for tying into the force main and the amount of a bond to be required for tying into the force main in case of a break. Commissioners Bronk and White favored having the Superintendent make the decision on the amount of the bond and keep the Board apprised. Brief discussion ensued.

2. Discussion of Town Meeting Warrant Article

Chairman Giberti reiterated information regarding the article and the need for support at the Town meeting. With cracked, deteriorated and leaking sewer line the cost of relining the sewer pipe would be the most cost effective way of addressing and correcting the problem rather than replacement of the sewer line.
