Request for Determination of Applicability (RDA)

- 1. Warren 176 Main St QOZB LLC, 176 Main Street, Wareham, MA To construct a small parking field, stormwater infiltration galleys, a 24' x 22.5' concrete patio, and a 2,000-gallon grease trap within Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage.
- 2. Kenneth and Teresa Lovely, 5 Priscilla Avenue, Wareham, MA Replace an existing 13" concrete wall in the same footprint as an existing concrete wall.
- **3.** Robert Peterson, 86 Shore Avenue, Wareham, MA To replace the existing deck attached to the rear of the house with a completely new deck of the same dimensions, new footings will be installed.


