

Design Public Hearing for Proposed Bridge Replacement

What is happening?

MassDOT will hold a hearing to inform the public about the proposed bridge replacement project in Marion/Wareham. The Department will discuss in depth the proposed project which will include the replacement of two bridges, Wareham Street (US 6) and Marion Road (US 6) both over the Weweantic River, and highway improvements.

How will this affect you?

The project will have temporary impacts to pedestrians and the motoring public during construction. The project will widen the causeway and provide a 10' wide shared use path on each side of the roadway for pedestrian and bicycle use in the final condition. The project will also provide bridge and roadway safety improvements. MassDOT proposes to employ staged construction maintaining at least 1 lane of travel in each direction and provide for pedestrian access throughout construction to minimize impacts to the public.
