



**Responses to Bidder Questions
Wareham, MA WPCF Improvements – Phase I (Contract No. 2021-WW-01)**

May 5, 2021

The following are questions received from contractors. This is **NOT** part of the addendum. This is for informational purposes only. Please note that some questions are paraphrased or combined. Questions that in our judgment are determined to be duplicates of questions that were already answered will not be repeated.

- 1. As the GC is now assigned work previously assigned to the HVAC and Electrical filed subbidders, will the Town extend the bid period?**

See Addendum No. 5 Item 1.

- 2. Per section 11310 1.01.B. and 2.05, it appears the submersible pump manufacturer is to provide a control panel, enclosure and additional power distribution to equipment furnished in other spec sections. Is it the intent to have this entire control panel furnished by the submersible pump supplier or is each equipment supplier providing their own control panel? Please clarify?**

The intent is that the Pump Supplier provides the control panel enclosure and power distribution for the pumps, mixers, and odor control system, including VFDs for the pumps and mixers. The PLC, UPS, and instrumentation will be provided by others, but delivered to the Pump Supplier / Pump Supplier's Control Panel Manufacturer for installation into the control panel. All internal control panel wiring and connections shall be by the Pump Supplier / Pump Supplier's Control Panel Manufacturer. The Mixer supplier will not provide a control panel. For Alternate No. 1, the Odor Control System Provider will provide the Odor Control Panel.

- 3. Section 11310 Item 2.05.A.2 notes the Odor Control System as specified in section 11381. Section 11381 item 1.01.A.11 and 2.05 also lists the control panel for the odor control system as being provided by the odor control system manufacturer. Please confirm who is responsible for this control panel?**

The Odor Control Panel is the responsibility of the Odor Control System provider and made part of Alternate No. 1. The circuit breaker that will provide power to the Odor Control Panel will be in the Pump Control Panel provided under 11310, under the Base Bid regardless of whether or not Alternate No. 1 is incorporated into the Contract.
