It has come to the attention of people, quite literally, across the world, through social media that the rescue organization listed above is being asked to disband or in the least remove several rescued animals from the property. Because of past complaints from one particular neighbor, issues that needed remediation have been rectified in the past several months including the relocation of several corrals and pens in order to correct a property line issue with this same neighbor. There are hundreds of photos and videos to corroborate the work that has been done on Kendra's property to make it pleasing to anyone who lives nearby.






