

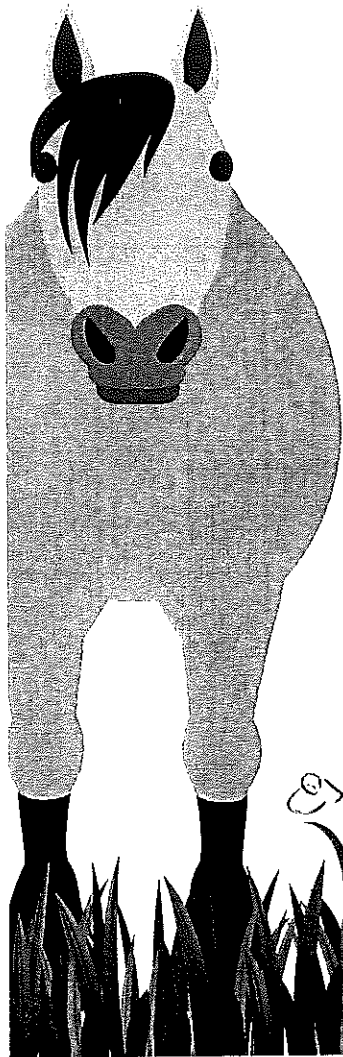

Kendra and her volunteer staff have brought joy to thousands of people from all over the world with her kindness, generosity, and love for many unfortunate animals.

This rescue has been saving animals for approximately 12 years. Kendra has compassionately united rescues and ordinary citizens like me that have a deep compassion for animals even going as far as to enforce compassion on her page. I am going to assume that the town/city/county ordinances have allowed her to do this for the animals. Any video I have seen has shown nothing but love and compassion for both the animals and her volunteers alike. She sincerely goes out of her way to give these animals their best chance at a life and a loving life at that before moving them on to their forever homes. On Thanksgiving Eve, 2021 my husband Steve was diagnosed with Parkinson's disease at the young age of 54. We are saddened knowing that our plans for retirement and growing old together will be drastically changed. Days after Steve's diagnosis, I was online when I came across a social media page named "Peace for Ponies" (aka Peace for all Animals). I'm not going into detail about who they are or what they do...you already know that. But I'm writing to let you know that I found joy in this very difficult time. I started following the page. It was so nice to have something so easily accessible that could take my mind off of things and make me feel happy. It wasn't long after, Steve started asking me questions about the sweet rescues too. There isn't a day that goes by that we don't wish that we lived closer.

Kendra, a 76ish year-old lady leading this all by herself. She has recruited an amazing volunteer staff and thousands of people like me from **all over the world** that love and support the work that they do.
