NREL is the only federal laboratory dedicated to the research, development, commercialization, and deployment of renewable energy and energy efficiency technologies. As part of its mission, NREL works closely with a number of private partners to transfer technological developments in renewable energy and energy efficiency technologies to the marketplace. NREL is a government-owned, contractor-operated (GOCO) facility, and is funded and overseen by the U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy (EERE). This contractual arrangement allows a private entity to operate the lab on behalf of the federal government under a Management and Operating (M&O) contract.
