SCOPE OF WORK

Replacement of Oakdale Playground Basketball Court

The Town of Wareham is seeking project proposals from qualified applicants and/or firms to perform a replacement of the existing basketball court in the Oakdale playground at 23 Apple Street, Wareham MA.

Qualified applicants and/or firms are invited to submit proposals in the format outlined in the specifications to the Town Administrator's office, Memorial Town Hall, 54 Marion Road, Wareham MA 02571 - no later than May 31, 2017, at 2:00 PM.

Project Specifications and Submission Requirements

2. General information and Bid Submission Requirement's:

The town of Wareham is seeking bids to perform a replacement of the existing basketball court and path at the Oakdale playground. The court size is 82' x 50'.

Deliverables include the following:

- Demolish the existing asphalt basketball court and remove materials from site
- Evaluate substrate for possible repair
- Provide the appropriate amount of asphalt for 82' x 50' basketball court (3" binder coat and 1.5" top coat)
- Lay appropriate thickness of asphalt on existing substrate
- Line stripe the court for basketball
- Demolish the existing asphalt path and remove materials from site
- Creation of a 154' x 4' wide asphalt path from parking area to basketball court

Prospective applicants shall submit three (3) copies of the project proposal no later than May 31, 2017, at 2:00 PM. to the Town Administrator, Town Hall, 54 Marion Road, Wareham MA 02571.

Activities will commence upon the selection and award of the contract and issuance of a notice to proceed. Expected completion date shall be ninety (90) days from the acceptance of the contract.

A maximum fee of \$5,000 has been established for this project. All labor must use prevailing wage. However, the fee will be subject to negotiation.
