BALLOT QUESTION

"Shall the revised Wareham Charter become effective as provided in Chapter 435 of the Acts of 2022 by acceptance of the voters at the Annual Town Election?"

Explanation:

The Wareham Charter is the town's governing document. Revisions to the Charter were approved as Article 22 and Article 23 at the June 12, 2021 Annual Spring Town Meeting. These revisions needed the approval of the Massachusetts Legislature, which approval was given by the Legislature's enactment of Chapter 435 of the Acts of 2022. Governor Baker signed the document on January 5, 2023. Chapter 435 of the Acts of 2022 provides that the Charter revisions will not become effective until acceptance by the voters by a vote on a ballot question.

A "Yes" vote on the ballot question is a vote in favor of authorizing the Charter revisions. A "No" vote on the ballot question is a vote against authorizing the Charter revisions.

The Charter revisions fall into two categories. The first category consists of formatting, grammatical and typographical changes. The second category consists of substantive changes including but not limited to:

- 1. Changing the membership of the Capital Planning Committee by substituting the Town Finance Director as a member instead of the Town Accountant.
- 2. Clarifying that the Sewer Commissioners are now elected officers.
- 3. Making the Town Clerk a position appointed by the Town Administrator.
- 4. Clarifying that the Sewer Superintendent is appointed by the Town Administrator.
- 5. Clarifying the process for removing a Town Administrator.
- 6. Adding language for a regular Charter review.
- 7. Adding definitions of terms used in the Charter.
