


Meeting opened at: 6:05

- Earl Russell presented the treasurer's report. Discussion held. Accepted report as written unanimous
- Jim Munise stated because we have recycling the town gets grants. He was asked who applies for these grants for Wareham? Discussion
- Jim said that Covanta wants to be the preferred hauler for Wareham. The district may sign by October. When the Wareham landfill closes Bourne will be taking ash at a price.
- Marilyn presented the co ordinator's report
- Marilyn reported that in the past Municipal Maint pay approx \$2,000.00 of the recycling pickups to ABC. The center now pays for them all at approx 3X higher fees. Bills have been submitted but no word yet if they will pay them. Discussion

- Marilyn reported new grant funds are still in the Governor's office waiting to be approved. Discussion
