



Wareham Board of Health Announces "Sharps" Collection To Begin June 1, 2004

The Wareham Board of Health is very pleased to announce the opening, on June 1, 2004, of a no-charge **Sharps Collection Program** for residents of Wareham.

This program is funded by the Wareham Board of Health and facilitated by the Wareham Recycling Committee and its volunteers. The collection site is located at the Recycling Drop-off Center in East Wareham, next to the Park-and-Ride, Rt. 28/Maple Springs Rd. and directly across from Atlantic Boats. Hours for collection will be Wednesday afternoons from 1 to 3 pm and Saturdays between 9 am and 1 pm.

Sharp's containers should be hard plastic bottles with screw type cap; preferably detergent type bottles, no larger than 24" in circumference or 1 gallon capacity. **Glass or clear plastic containers will not be accepted.** If available, appropriate type bottles may be obtained at the Recycling Center. Encourage friends to donate used detergent bottles for use in the program.
