DIRECTIONS: Rte 6 into Marion – go through 2 sets of lights – go past the Sippican Office Park – take second right (across from Marion Police Station) onto Benson Brook Road

ACCEPTED MATERIALS:

Household Trash

Recyclables (pre-sorted & clean)

Clean, loose newsprint (no plastic or paper bags)

Cardboard and paper: including magazines, computer paper, corrugated cardboard, flat cereal boxes and junk mail

Co-Mingles: glass, plastic, tin and aluminum

Light Metal: stoves, dryer, washers, bikes, gas-grills, lawnmowers (no gas or oil), water heaters, microwave ovens, dish washers & other misc metals

Empty Propane Tanks

Florescent Light Bulbs

The following items will be accepted for a tag fee of \$25.00

Refrigerator/Freezer/ Air Conditioner/ Television/Computer Monitor/Humidifer/

De-Humidifier (purchase the tag at the Wareham Dept. of Natural Resources Office –

Multi Service Center 48 Marion Road Wareham, 2nd floor) to be disposed at the Marion Site Only.

Compost Facility Regulations

Effective April 2018

Per order of the CMW Regional Disposal District Committee the compost pile located at the Marion landfill has been closed until further notice while the CMWRDD undergoes reorganization.

Due to the closure the Town of Wareham Municipal Maintenance Department will temporarily be accepting compostable leaves and yard waste during this time:

- **When:** *Second and Fourth Saturday of each month*
- **Time:** 8:00 am to 3:00 pm
- **Where:** 95 Charge Pond Road, Wareham (1/2 mile past the Wareham YMCA)
- **Compost Regulations:**
 - Clean leaves and grass clippings only, any mixed trash, branches or non-compostable materials will be refused.
 - All compostable products must be removed from plastic bags
 - Biodegradable paper compost bags are permissible
 - Commercial haulers are prohibited
- **Brush Regulations:**
 - Brush shall be no more than 3" in diameter
 - Brush shall be cut into 3' lengths
 - Stumps and logs prohibited
 - Commercial haulers are prohibited

Each resident vehicle using the Compost Facility is required to have a current Wareham transfer station sticker.

Resident permits may be purchased at the Department of Natural Resources main office located in the Multi-Service Building at 48 Marion Road, Monday through Friday, 8:30am to 4:00pm. A vehicle registration and proof of residency is required, contact the WDNR main office at 508-291-3100 x 3180 if you have any questions.

RECYCLING FACTS:

- Over 75% of Waste is recyclable, but we only recycle 30% of it.
- Recycling 100 aluminum cans could light your bedroom for 2 whole weeks.

- Tin and Aluminum Cans
- Aluminum foil and trays (clean)
- Bottles and Jars (no plate glass)
- Cardboard (separate from paper)
- Packing "peanuts" - no Styrofoam
- Sharps—in closed plastic container—check for appropriate size
- Book Barn
- Mercury Bearing Items - Fluorescent bulbs, etc.

Small Fee (prices subject to change):

- Auto Tires -No Rim (\$2.00)
- Auto Tires With Rim (\$3.00)
- Auto Batteries (\$2.00)
- White Goods (no sticker required) \$20 for Non-Freon items (washers, dryers, etc.)
- \$25 for items containing Freon (refrigerators, freezers, etc.)
- TV's (up to 32"), computers, laptops, printers, monitors, etc. (prices & items accepted are subject to change).

Small Fee (May)-Oct.

- Latex and Oil Paint (no marine), Varnish, Stains, Thinners
- \$1.00/gallon

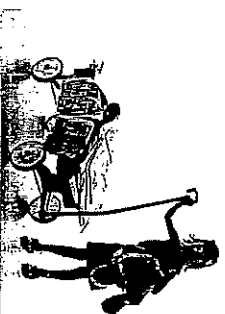
- No Trash Taken—Contract with Licensed Haulers (contact Board of Health (508-291-3100 ext.3197) for listing.
