You may obtain, in person or by mail, a marriage certificate from the Town Clerk's Office at the following address:

The Town Clerk's Office hours are: Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday, 8:15AM- 6:00PM and Tuesday 8:15AM- 6:30PM. Office is closed on Friday.

The fee is \$10.00 per certified copy. The Town accepts checks and money orders by mail. No out of state personal checks will be accepted. Checks should be made payable to the "*Town of Wareham*." Checks, money orders, or cash are accepted in person. We do not accept debit or credit card payments.
