At the September 3, 2015 meeting, the Veterans Council voted on the following definition of a "Veteran" for the purpose of being included on the "Memorial Boards" in the vestibule of Wareham Memorial Town Hall.

To be included on the Memorial Boards, **Any person having:**

Served 180 days active duty in the Armed Forces or Merchant Marines- of the United States,

Received an Honorable, General or Medical discharge from the service and,

Was a resident of the Town of Wareham (irrespective of mailing address) upon their entry into military service or was "Killed In Action"

may request, or be nominated to have their name placed on the Memorial Boards in Wareham Memorial Town Hall.

Additionally, the Council voted to identify Combat Veterans, as indicated on their DD214 or with other substantiating documentation, with a star next to their name.

Note: I am sending this document to James Crockett for his comment as well before sending it out to all members and other interested parties. There may be some issues that we did not see or discuss during our deliberation and vote.
